

# Lufkin Road Middle School

## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Registration 2008-2009

Welcome to Lufkin Road Middle School. We are pleased that you have chosen Lufkin Road for your child's school. Sixth graders will take the following core classes, which account for five periods of their day:

-Language Arts      -Social Studies      -Science      -Math      -Health/Physical Education

Another two periods will consist of our specials. A student will have two of the following choices:

- One class period will offer
- ♦ **Exploratory Wheel:** A combination of two of four classes running nine weeks each. These 9-week classes are: Music Exploratory, Art Exploratory, Exploring Careers, and Exploring Spanish. Offerings will differ with each track. The other semester will be 18 weeks of **Computer Keyboarding**. This will complete a semester.
- The other class period offerings are:
- ♦ **Band:** which is a yearlong class. A student must take sixth grade band if he/she wishes to participate in band during seventh and eighth grade.
- ♦ **Core Enrichment Opportunities (CEO):** This class will be an enrichment of Language Arts, Math, Science or Social Studies. Students will rotate classes on the team with their core teachers.
- ♦ **CEO- Guided Study:** A guided study class is offered for those students that need additional support to be academically successful and/or improve their organization skills. **If your child has not met Board requirements for EOG scores, this period may be used for Reading and/or Math remediation.**

During the first 3-week period of CEO, all students will have a Transition to Middle School class. The focus of this class is study and note taking skills, organizational skills, and even time to get started on homework. It will be a class geared to getting our 6<sup>th</sup> graders off to a good start in their middle school years. Starting the fourth week, students will break out into the Core Enrichment or the Guided Study class.

- ❖ **Curriculum Assistance (CA):** a yearlong class only offered to **students with an IEP**. This could be offered either period, depending on the other choice of classes.

Each of these class offerings requires a commitment by the student. Your selections will determine the completion of your child's schedule. Below are the combinations offered. **Please check (✓) your 1 choice for the classes you wish.**
