



Managing Your Student's Child Nutrition Account

Our Managers are Available to Help

Students in Wake County Public Schools are assigned a bar code number to be used in the cafeteria. This number identifies your student to the Child Nutrition staff at his or her school. It also allows you to apply funds to an account and eliminate the need for remembering and carrying lunch money on a daily basis. Our Point of Sale software also allows us to, at the parent or guardian's request, flag a student's account with specific information, such as special diet needs and account restrictions.

Talk to your student's school cafeteria manager about

- Obtaining a printed copy of the record of sales on your student's account over a period of time
- Restricting sales with flags such as
 - "Lunch Only"
 - "Breakfast & Lunch Only"
 - "No Snacks"
 - "Extra Sales: Milk Only"
 - "\$2.00 limit" per day
 - "Snacks on Fridays Only"

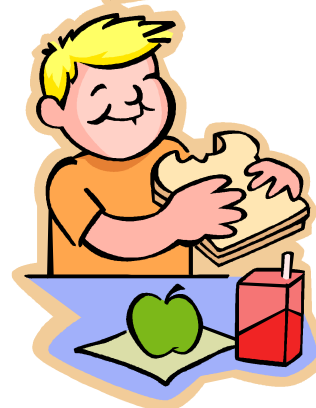
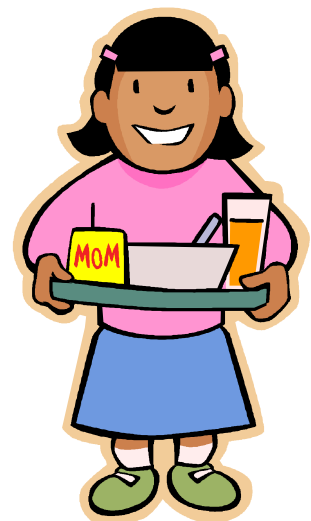
Another option that has worked well for some parents is to restrict the account to "No Extra Sales" and then send cash with their child when they're allowing extra purchases – for example, each Friday.

These flags will show up on the memo screen of the register as your student goes through the line. Our cashiers are trained to diligently watch for the notifications with each child, but at times, in the effort to serve the students quickly, a flag may be overlooked.

Simply go to www.myLunchMoney.com to enroll and start using the site to deposit funds into your child's lunch account. Once your account is established, you can check balances and fund the account anytime from your home computer, phone or fax. Your child's information is safe--it stays at school. Your personal and payment card information is protected by the most advanced Internet security.

Funds will be posted on your child's account in 24 to 48 hours. There is a \$1.95 service charge for each transaction per school.
