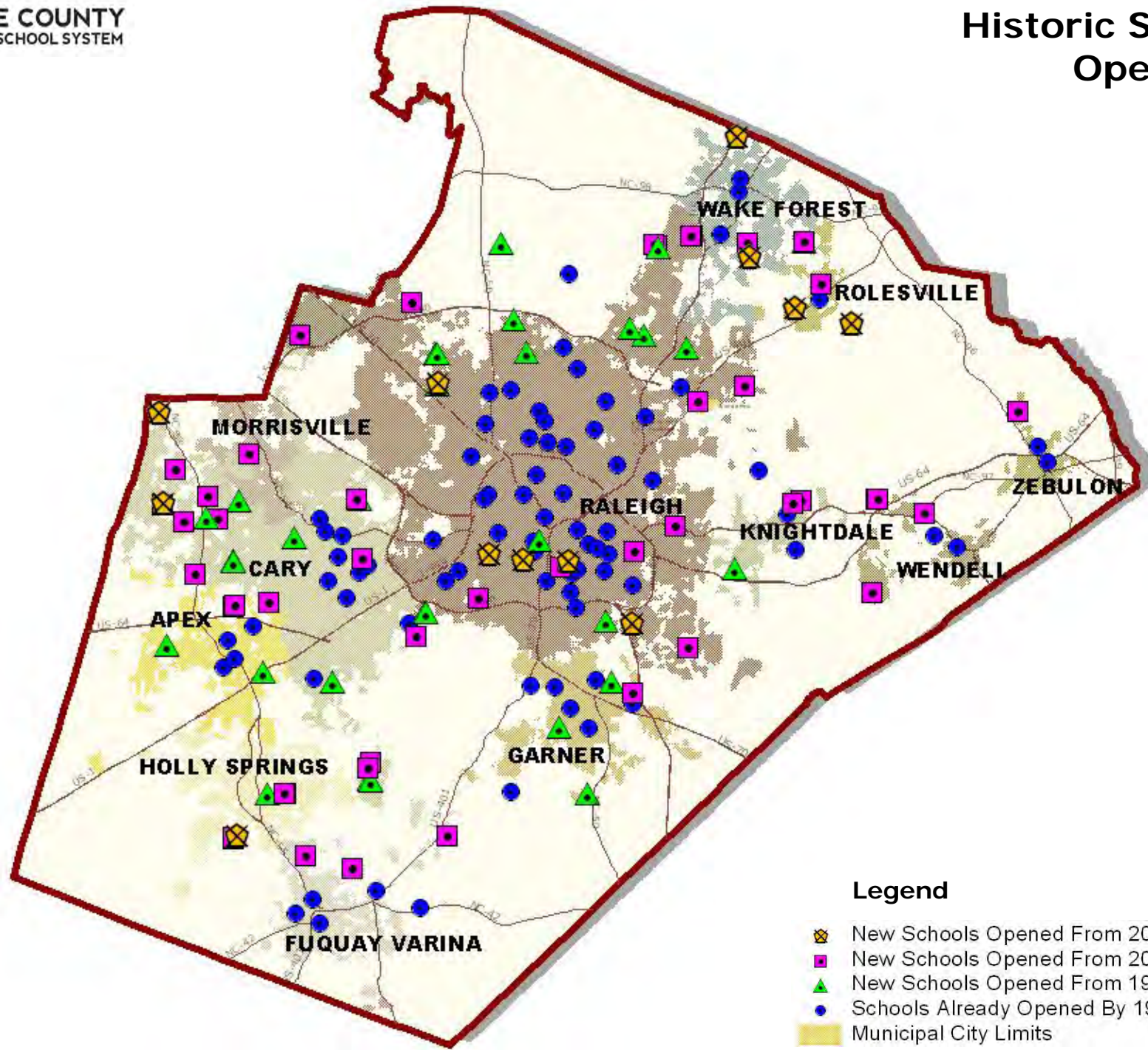

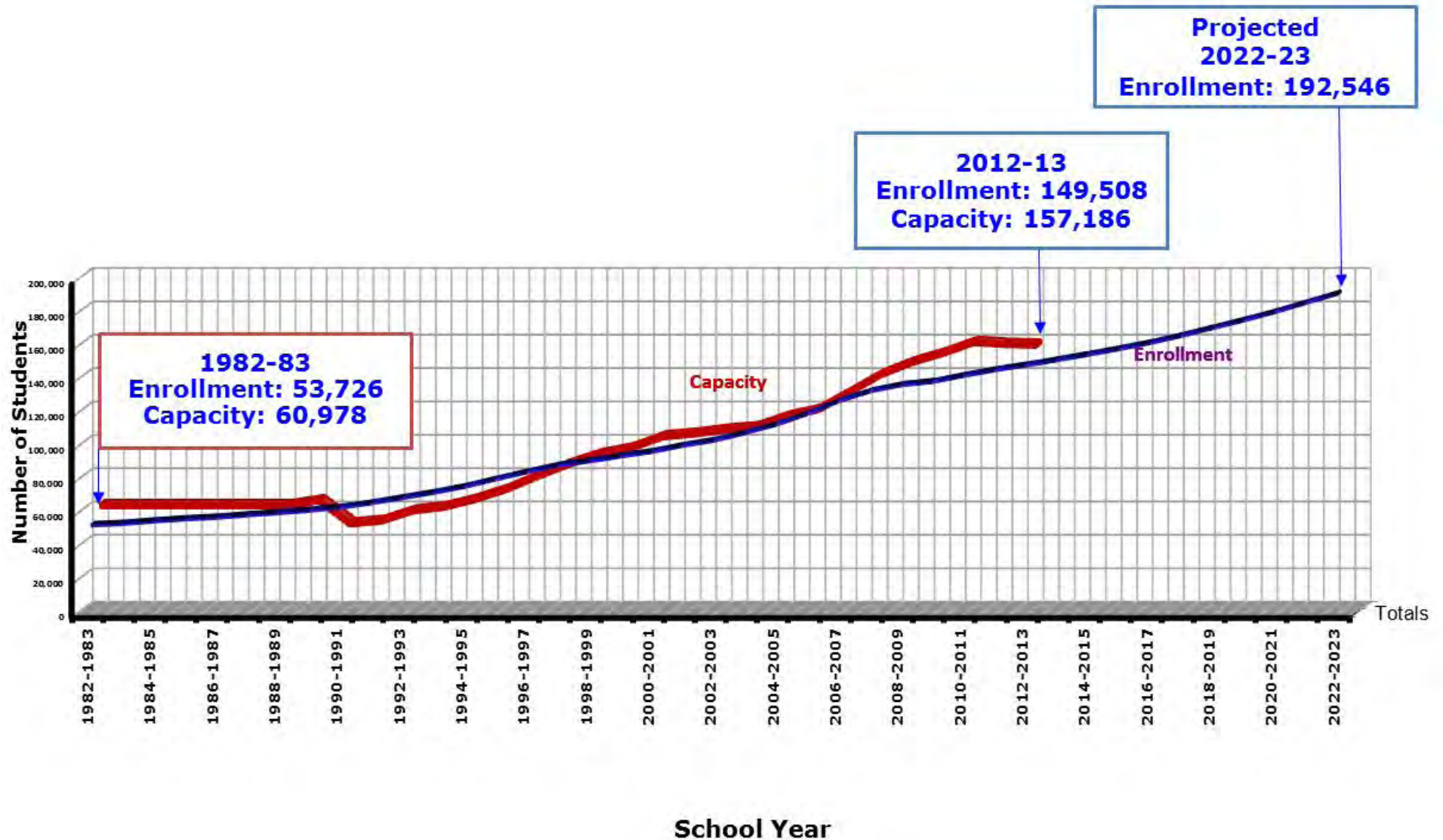

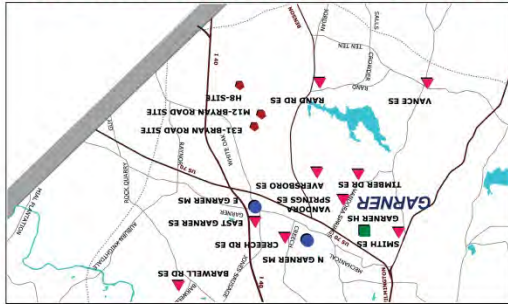

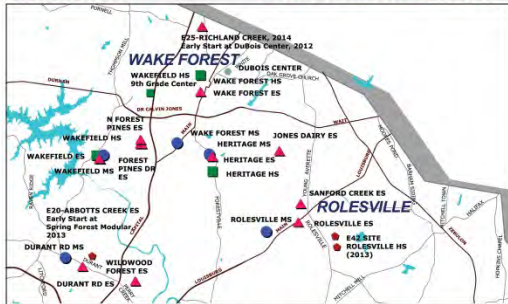


MAP INSET 4 FUQUAY-VARINA/HOLLY SPRINGS

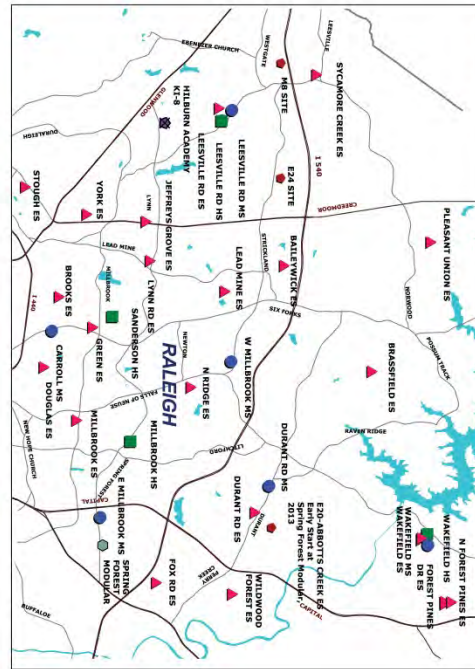
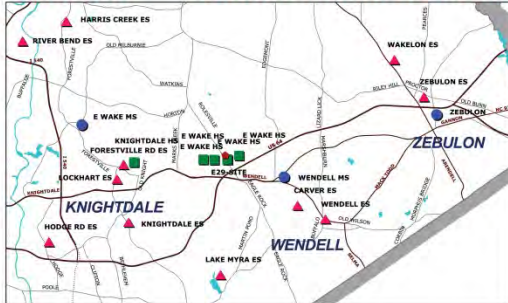


MAP INSET 3 GARNER

MAP INSET 5 WAKE FOREST/ROLESVILLE



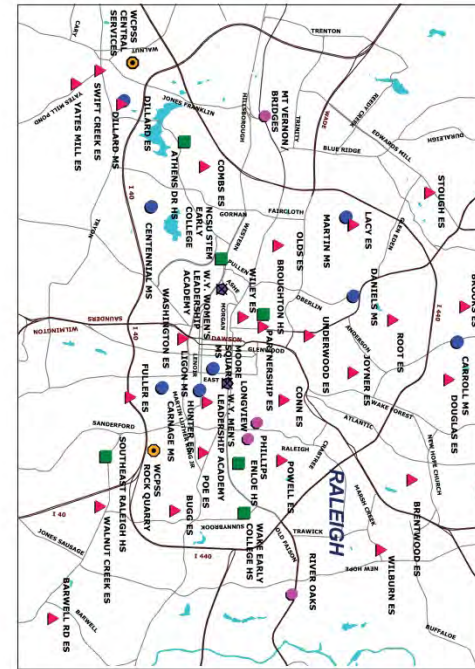
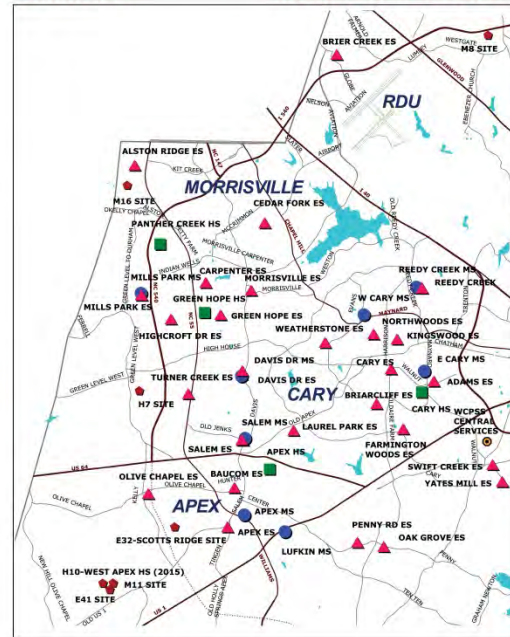
MAP INSET 6 KNIGHTDALE/WENDELL/ZEBULON
