Transcripts

IN-STATE COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES

WCPSS high schools use the College Foundation of North Carolina (CFNC) Electronic Transcript as the primary method of sending senior transcripts to institutions of higher education in North Carolina. All North Carolina colleges, universities and community colleges accept the CFNC Electronic Transcript. These transcripts are <u>free</u> to current seniors and are sent within 1-2 days of the request through the student CFNC account online.

OUT-OF-STATE COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES/NCAA/SCHOLARSHIPS

WCPSS offers a secure site for current and former students to access transcripts, attendance, and employment verifications. https://wcpss.scriborder.com/

Please allow 7-10 business days to process student record orders. Requests for information must be completed online and will be processed on normal business days during normal business hours (Monday-Friday 8:00 AM-4:00 PM). You will receive emails from scribonline@scribsoft.com to notify you of the status of your order. It is important you read those emails carefully as additional information may be required to process your request.

Final Transcript

All students planning to attend college must send a FINAL transcript to their admissions office. If your initial transcript was sent through Common Application, a final transcript will automatically be sent approximately 10 days after graduation. For all other transcripts, students will need to submit a new request through CFNC or scriborder.

<u>COLLEGE ACCEPTANCE LETTERS/SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS:</u> Please report all scholarship awards and college acceptance letters to Student Services ASAP for recognition at Senior Awards Night.

<u>AT-RISK MID-YEAR GRADUATES:</u> Only students who meet all graduation requirements will be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony. Students who do not meet graduation requirements will be notified Jan 23rd by 3:00 PM

- ARRIVAL: <u>Students should report no later than 7:45 AM</u>. Students who are not present for rehearsal will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- **ATTIRE:** Dress comfortably, do not wear caps & gowns to practice. Girls should bring the shoes they plan on wearing on graduation day to practice walking across the stage.
- BEHAVIOR: Graduation practice and ceremony are both school-related activities and students are
 expected to adhere to the WCPSS Student Code of Conduct outlined in the WCPSS Student handbook.
 Students who do not behave appropriately will not be allowed to participate in the graduation
 ceremony.
- TICKETS: Graduation tickets will be distributed at the graduation rehearsal practice. Each graduate will receive <u>8</u> guest admission tickets. (*Tickets will not be given to students who have not paid all school fees and fines*).

- ARRIVAL: <u>Students should report to Room 1309 no later than 5:30 PM</u>. Doors will open at 6:00 pm for guests to enter the auditorium.
- **TIME:** The allotted time for the ceremony is 1 hour.
- ATTIRE: Students should arrive dressed in the appropriate graduation attire
- **EXTRA ITEMS:** Students should not bring extra items to the graduation ceremony. (No electronic devices, cell phones, purses, keys, cameras, etc. These items cannot be secured during the ceremony.)
- **DIPLOMAS:** Students will receive diploma covers as they cross the stage. Diplomas will be issued immediately following the ceremony in **Room 1309**. Diplomas will not be issued to seniors who display inappropriate behavior at any time during the ceremony. Students who have their diplomas held due to inappropriate behavior will have to make an appointment to meet with Mrs. Lassiter to receive it.
- A final report card and unofficial transcript will be mailed to each graduate
- **GUESTS:** Each senior will receive **8** guest tickets for the graduation ceremony.
- **PROHIBITED ITEMS:** balloons, camera bags, book bags/backpacks, glass containers, food/drink, noise makers, wrapped packages of any kind, or any items similar to those listed above. Flowers wrapped in tissue paper are allowed inside the building. Intoxicated individuals will not be allowed to enter the exhibit floor area.
- **Photographer:** A professional photographer from Lifetouch will take pictures of each graduate as they receive their diploma and exit the stage.

Graduation Etiquette and Attire

The faculty and staff of Rolesville High School want to make graduation a most memorable experience. We ask for your full cooperation with the dress code.

Caps and gowns should always be worn in a dignified way. Be sure the gowns are neatly pressed.

(Use COOL iron – the gowns will melt!)

Both men and women always wear caps STRAIGHT on the head, parallel to the floor. A teacher supervisor will adjust this for you if you are not wearing the cap correctly. No hat decorations/alterations are allowed.

*Tassels are to be worn on the right (and will be turned left at the ceremony).

Seniors will line up in alphabetical order. Upon hearing his/her name called, each senior will walk across the stage and receive his/her diploma from the Principal.

<u>LADIES:</u> Wear black dresses, or black skirt & black dress shirt and black shoes. Dresses should not hang below the gown. Ladies should wear shoes with a low heel. <u>Do not</u> wear sandals, flip-flops or colorful hosiery.

GENTLEMEN: Wear black dress slacks, white long-sleeved dress shirt, black dress tie, black dress socks and black dress shoes.

THOSE WEARING INAPPROPRIATE ATTIRE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE. NO EXCEPTIONS, NO EXCUSES!!

PROHIBITED ITEMS: Balloons, camera bags, book bags/backpacks, glass containers, food/drinks, noise makers, wrapped packages of any kind, or items similar to those listed above. Flowers wrapped in tissue paper are allowed.

Parents/guests are asked not to applaud, yell, or cheer when their student's name is called. Everyone wants the respect of hearing his/her child's name read. Celebrating the students will be done once all the names have been called.
