Dear Fuquay-Varina High School Parent(s) / Guardian(s):

We would like you to be aware of a lockdown drill we conducted at school today, April 20, 2015. Our purpose for a lockdown drill is to practice and continue to improve our safety processes and procedures. By law, we conduct two lockdown drills per year.

Safety is a priority for all WCPSS schools. In the event of an actual emergency, we confer and coordinate with WCPSS security and local law enforcement. Local law enforcement officials investigating events in the community near a school may deem it necessary to issue a lockdown if they feel that the external event potentially provides a threat to that school. They notify WCPSS security staff, the school, and may recommend a lockdown in that instance.

We conducted today's drill so that faculty, students, and our community are familiar with these procedures. By working with our law enforcement agency and WCPSS security staff on the drills at WCPSS schools, we can better prepare our students, faculty, and staff for the unexpected.
