Release Time for Next Year's Seniors

Any student who will be a senior next year should have submitted their Release Time Requests by April 1. We have extended the deadline to Tuesday, April 12. Release forms can be found on our website under Students >Forms>Release Forms. Some seniors choose a reduced schedule so they can work to earn money, study extra for challenging AP courses, or practice longer hours as they prepare to pursue the arts or athletics beyond high school. Be sure to check with potential colleges to understand their position on reduced schedules in high school prior to making this decision. To accurately build a master schedule to accommodate student need and interest, we need to plan for student release time now. When students request release time after our schedule is set, it hinders our ability to maximize our limited resources. Release requests submitted after April 12 will only be approved with a documented medical or other hardship.
