Leaving Campus after Exams

In the fall, most parents gave permission for their students to leave campus upon the conclusion of the exam period. This permission to leave remains in place for the June final exams. Just like the fall exams, students who leave at the conclusion of exams will not have access to bus service and will not be allowed to return to campus after leaving. Students who need to access the bus or otherwise do not have parent permission to leave campus must remain on campus until 2:18. If you would like to retract permission for your child to leave immediately concluding the exam session, you may complete a new form and return it to the main office prior to exams. A new form is included with the Bimonthly Bulletin and posted on our website. All students who do not currently have permission to leave campus at the end of exams will be given a new form to take home if parents would like to provide permission. Dear Parents:

Beginning last year, based on a variety of factors at the district level, we are no longer able to offer bus service at the conclusion of our exams. **Instead, we will begin our dismissal and transition to buses at our regularly scheduled time of 2:18 during exam week. With written parental permission, students may still leave campus at the conclusion of 2nd Semester Exams if they do not need bus service.** Students who need bus service will be permitted to remain on campus until our regular dismissal time of 2:18.

2nd Semester Exams will be held Friday, June 3 through Thursday, June 9. Exams will end at 12:37 on Friday and Monday. Exams will end at 11:45 on Tuesday and Wednesday. Thursday is an exam make-up day.

Only students with a completed form providing parental permission may leave campus at the conclusion of exams. Please note that only students remaining on campus will be allowed to ride the bus at 2:18. Once students leave campus, they may not return to ride the bus.

Notes:

- 1. In the left column, CTE stands for Career & Technical Education.
- 2. All buses will run at 2:18 on exam days.
- 3. Students may leave campus at the conclusion of exams with a completed permission form signed by their parents. Once students leave campus for the day, they may not return.
- 4. Students remaining on campus after exams are to report to lunch and the designated class or area for the day.
- 5. All students in grades 9-11 should report to school on June 3 and 6. On June 7 and 8, only students with a scheduled EOC should report to campus.
- 6. Students should speak with their math teacher if they are unclear on which day they should take the Math I EOC.
- 7. Make-up exams will be administered by appointment with the teacher.
- 8. Students must be present at the beginning of each exam period to take the exam. Students must be present for the entire exam period to receive credit for the exam.
- 9. Students who are on campus during an exam period for which they do not have an exam or scheduled review session must report to Student Services.
- 10. The campuses of Leesville Road Elementary School and Leesville Road Middle School, as well as other Wake County schools, are strictly off limits on these dates to Leesville Road High School students.
- 11. In all courses with an End-of-Course (EOC) test, the EOC test shall count as 25% of the student's final grade. In courses without an EOC test, the final exam shall count as 20% of the student's final grade.
