IMPORTANT: The email address must already be on file in the district student information system.

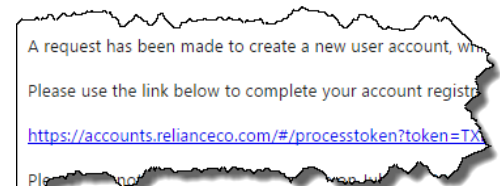
4. Enter a **password**. It must contain the following:

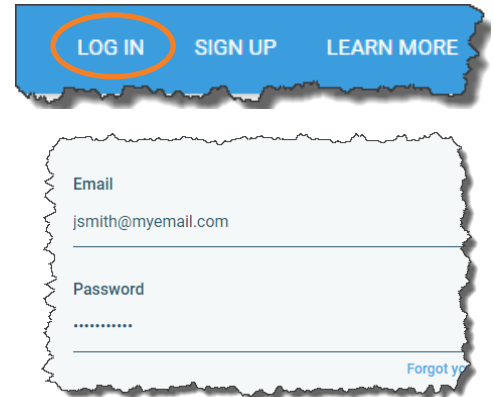

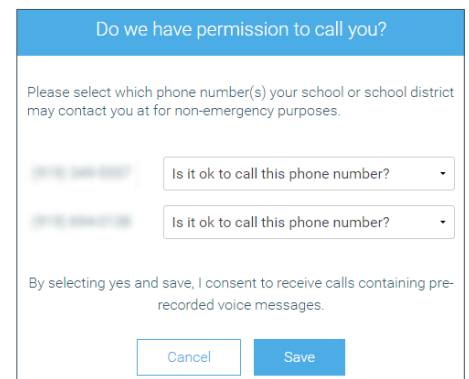

The first time you log into SchoolMessenger, you will be asked to grant permission for each phone number associated with your account.

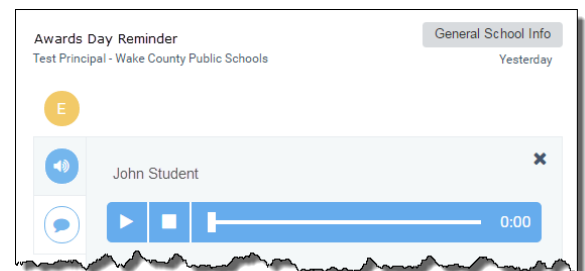

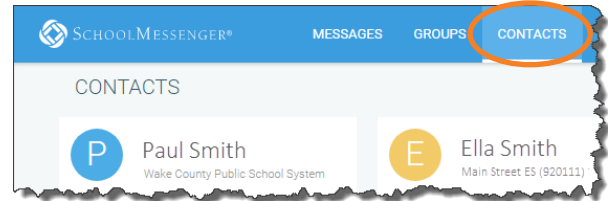
After SchoolMessenger sign in, your messages will be displayed. Messages are saved for **30 days**.

Click **CONTACTS** to view the students associated with your account. If you do not see all your students, contact the student's school to make sure your contact information is current.



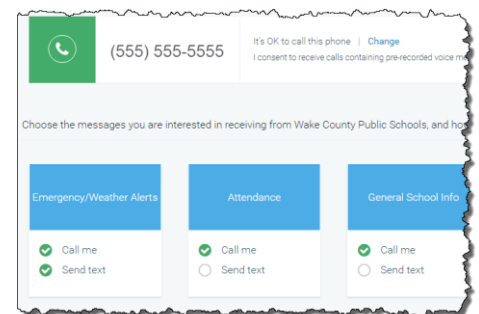
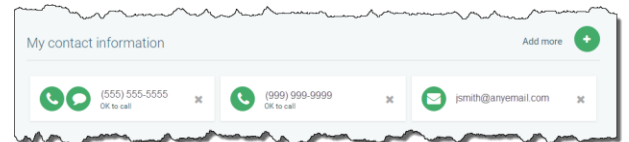
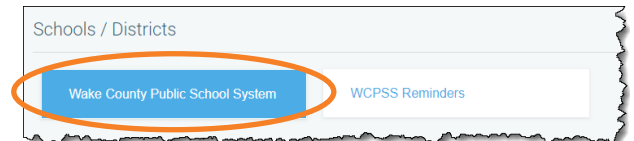
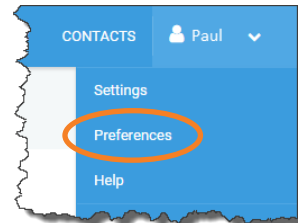
Select Contact Preferences

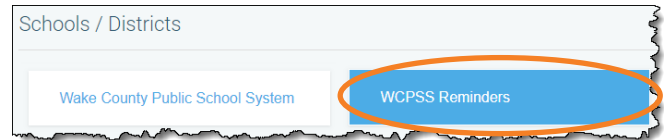
