How	What was the way the story happen.
Why	What was the reason.
Retell	To tell a story again in your own words
Question	To ask about something I don't know.
Wonder	To have interest in something, to be curious about something.
Prediction	Talking about what might happen next.
Compare	To find how 2 or more things are the same.
Contrast	To find how 2 or more things are different.
Summarize	To tell the story again using your own words.
Details	Information about the story, characters, setting, etc.
Problem	A question, puzzle, or difficult situation that needs to be solved.

Solution	The answer to a problem or difficult situation.
Text Features	Anything that helps the reader.
Sequence	The order in which things happen, like first, then, last.
Plot	The main idea or problem of a story.
