Each spring, we will hold a planning meeting to discuss and prepare for the next year. We will follow up on this discussion at the start of the new school year. Parents can give their input and approval of policies through web surveys and/or paper copies sent home.

• Process for providing parents with timely information:

All information sent home to parents will be included in Tuesday folders. We will send home Home/School Connections and Reading Connection Newsletters monthly as well as invitations to PAC meetings. Additional individualized information will be shared with parents at parent/teacher conferences and /or phone calls when appropriate.

• Description of how curriculum and assessment will be shared with parents:

At our first annual meeting, we will give parents information on the types of assessment we use to determine placement in the Title 1 PROGRAM. The results of these assessments are used to drive instruction. We will also share information about the research-based practice and materials used to increase students' comprehension, fluency, and word work skills.
