Exam Schedule Information:

- **On Friday, June 3 and Monday, June 6**, students must remain in their classrooms for the duration of the exam block. In order to maintain the integrity of all assessments and provide optimum opportunity for success for all students, **students will not be permitted to check out early during exam blocks**. Please schedule appointments, etc. accordingly.
- **On Tuesday, June 7 and Wednesday, June 8**, only students taking Biology, English II, and Math I (semester course) are required to attend school. These EOC administrations have specific technical and logistical requirements that necessitate they be given in isolation on Wednesday and Thursday. These students will participate in exam reviews during their exam periods on June 3 and 6.
- **Early Departure on Tuesday, June 7 and Wednesday, June 8**. The exam period will end around 10:40am. Testing students who return signed parent permission forms allowing them to leave campus may leave campus at 10:40am. Students who do not return signed parent permission forms must remain on campus in designated areas until the buses leave at 2:18 pm. For students remaining on campus, lunch will be served, but students must remain in the cafeteria. The parent permission form must be returned to the main office no later than the morning of the student's EOC exam in order for the student to leave at 10:40am. Students who leave campus without appropriate documentation will be subject to consequences aligned with the school's disciplinary guidelines.
- **Late Arrival To Exams**. Students arriving late to school will not be allowed to test. They will need to attend a make-up session on June 9.
- **Make Up Exam Days**: Thursday, June 9 is the only make-up day for exams. Only students who miss an exam must report to campus this day to make-up any missed exams. Bus routes will only run on this date where we know that a student is planning to attend and has made us aware that they will utilize their normal WCPSS Bus Transportation.
- **Senior Exam For Periods 3 & 4**: Seniors who have 3rd & 4th period exams will need to take those on Thursday, June 2 in order to have final grades/credits confirmed prior to graduation practice on June 6.
- **Senior Exam Exemptions**: Seniors cannot be exempt from a state exam: CTE Exams and End-of-Course (EOC) exams. Seniors can only be exempt from a teacher-made exam. Seniors will be exempt from non-State exams under the following parameters: 3 or fewer excused absences with an A average, 2 or fewer excused absences with a B average, 1 or fewer excused absences with a C average. Please refer to the HSHS Student Handbook for more details on senior exam exemptions.

Exam Schedule Information:

This exam schedule different for seniors because of some specific issues that we needed to work around including: (1) the state will not permit us to give CTE exams prior to June 3, and (2) we believe that we should know that seniors have met graduation requirements before participating in graduation rehearsal.

- **On Thursday, June 2**, seniors who are not exempt from their teacher made exams for 3rd and 4th period will report to school and take their exams. Seniors will depart campus when they have concluded their exams. Seniors who have a 3rd or 4th period CTE exams will attend those classes on this date for exam review. Third and 4th period CTE exams will be on June 6.
- **On Friday, June 3**, seniors will report to school to take 1st and 2nd period exams regardless of what that exam is. This will include teacher-made exams and CTE exams. Seniors will operate on the same schedule as underclassmen on this date.
- **On Monday, June 6**, seniors who have a CTE exam during 3rd or 4th period will report to school and take that exam at 7:25am. Seniors will leave campus at the conclusion of that exam period.
- **Late Arrival To Exams.** Students arriving late to school will not be allowed to test. They will need to attend a make-up session on June 7-9.
- **Make Up Exam Days:** Only students who miss an exam must report to campus this day to make-up any missed exams. Bus routes will only run on these date where we know that a student is planning to attend and has made us aware that they will utilize their normal WCPSS Bus Transportation.
- **Senior Exam Exemptions:** Seniors cannot be exempt from a state exam: CTE Exams and End-of-Course (EOC) exams. Seniors can only be exempt from a teacher-made exam. Seniors will be exempt from non-State exams under the following parameters: 3 or fewer excused absences with an A average, 2 or fewer excused absences with a B average, 1 or fewer excused absences with a C average. Please refer to the HSHS Student Handbook for more details on senior exam exemptions.
