1. Thank you for your interest in Wake County School's Driver Education program, operated by Jordan Driving School, Inc. For after school classes at a public high school, turn the completed form in at the high school. For alternative classes, refer to the Jordan Driving School website.

- 2. Once the Lead Teacher has compiled the registration forms for class, you will be contacted by telephone call or email to verify which class you were assigned to. Once you receive this notification, you must pay your Driver Education fee to confirm your seat in the class. Paying online through the WCPSS credit card terminal is our preferred method of payment. Once you pay online through the WCPSS online terminal, a notification email is sent to the Lead Teacher of that school which will verify your payment. You will also receive an email from the WCPSS terminal confirming your payment. If you do not have access to the internet or a credit card, you may pay by cash or money order directly to our administrative office. Personal checks are not accepted. Money orders should be made payable to "Jordan Driving School."
- 3. In the State of North Carolina, there is a \$65 fee to enroll in Driver Education class. This fee, paid by parents, covers only the classroom portion of Driver Education. There will be no refunds given for students who take a seat in class and dropout or fail. Attendance, behavior, or academic failures are all considered forfeits of your classroom fee. Should the student be allowed to retake the classroom portion, the fee must be paid again. In the State of North Carolina, the behind the wheel portion is subsidized and is offered to students enrolled in Wake County Schools at no charge one time.
- 4. You must be in attendance all 30 hours of class instruction or you will be dropped from the class. Failure to comply with attendance standards will result in an automatic failure. Do not register for a class if you have a schedule conflict with a date of the class.
- 5. All students must follow WCPSS guidelines. Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in dismissal from the class.
- 6. You should bring pencils, paper, and a photocopy of your birth certificate to class. Do not attach a copy of the birth certificate to the registration form.
- 7. You must provide your own transportation to and from driver education class.

How to pay after the student has been accepted into the class:

You may access the WCPSS online payment system at JordanDriving.com. From the home page, select CLASS SCHEDULES & ONLINE PAYMENTS. Click on the type of class (ex. Public School After School Classes, etc), Click on School Location, Click on the "blue" Pay Here button, beside the class date/time(s) your student was assigned to.

Please understand that WCPSS High School locations are not prepared to collect fees and under no circumstances should you contact the school, principal, or bookkeeper attempting to pay a driver education fee. Jordan Driving School is contracted to WCPSS to provide Driver Education and is ultimately responsible for collecting fees.

You must be at least 14 years 6 months by the first day of the class. We assign students to class based on age, oldest to youngest. In other words, if 50 students request the month of September as their first choice, the September class will first be offered to the oldest 35 students. There must be a minimum of 35 students paid on the first day of class or the class will be cancelled.
