## **Exam Schedule Information:**

- From Wednesday, January 18<sup>th</sup> through Monday, January 23<sup>rd</sup> students must remain in their classrooms for the duration of the exam block. In order to maintain the integrity of all assessments and provide optimum opportunity for success for all students, students will not be permitted to check out early during exam blocks. Please schedule appointments, etc. accordingly.
- **Exam Weighting** All exams including EOCs, NCFEs, CTE exams, and teacher made exams will constitute 20% of the total final grade for each course.
- Early Departure Students may leave school AFTER the exam window if they have submitted their early dismissal form. Once students leave campus after their exam, they may not return without a parent/guardian. Students should not be on other school campuses during exam days. Buses will depart at 2:18 pm each day with the exception of Friday's ER day. Buses will run at 11:45 am on Friday's ER day. Students remaining on campus must be under the supervision of a staff member. Optional independent study halls will be available for students.
- Late Arrival to Exams Students arriving after 7:20 am will have to take their exam on Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>, the make-up day. All exams must be taken by Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
- Senior Exam Exemptions Seniors cannot be exempt from a state exam (NCFE, CTE and EOC exams.) Seniors can only be exempt from a teacher-made exam. If the senior student qualifies as exempt, according to the guidelines listed below, he/she will not need to attend the exam session.

## **Attendance Requirements for Exam Exemption**

- \*Seniors lose exam exemption if they have any unexcused absence.
- \*Seniors may be exempt with:
  - 3 or fewer absences with an A average
  - 2 or fewer absences with a B average
  - 1 or fewer absences with a C average

A College Visitation Day is excused when the senior provides the prior excusal form 1710 and proper documentation of the visit period. However, the day(s) absent for a college visit are still recorded as absences and count toward exam exemptions for seniors.
