

Election Day Tuesday, November 8th

WCPSS Schools Operate on 2 Hour Delay

Please be aware that all Wake County schools will open on a two-hour delay Tuesday, November 8th because of the anticipated high traffic on Election Day. The Wake County Board of Elections will use the FWES Cafeteria from 5am-10pm on November 8, 2016.

Farmington Woods students will be allowed to enter the building at 10:45am and Instruction will begin at 11:15am.

- Schools buses will pick up students two hours later than their regular daily schedule.
- All families of carpoolers and walkers are encouraged to use the carpool lane for drop off and pick up during arrival and dismissal on November 8th due to the election- there will be limited parking available and we expect high traffic around the school
- No Breakfast will be served due to late start
- No visitors may come for lunch as all classes will eat lunch in the classrooms on November 8th
- Students will have opportunity to purchase lunch from cafeteria during lunch period. These students will be escorted to/from cafeteria by instructional assistants for this purpose.
- Before-school program will operate on their normal start time
 - 7:00am at Farmington Woods- sign in Room 609- park at bus lot and enter by walking sidewalk beside classrooms on Green Hall
- After-school program will operate on regular hours-
 - Sign out in Room 609- park in bus lot and enter by walking sidewalk beside classrooms on Green Hall.
- PM Carpool: Carpool students will exit from the exterior door of orange hall classrooms (202, 204, 206 and 208) and follow adults to the carpool loading area. Carpool loading area is unchanged.
