Open House Parking:

We will have lots of cars for very few parking spaces at Open House. Security will be on campus to assist with parking in designated spots and on our back field. Families also have permission to use the church parking lot at Seabrook Ave and Cary Pkwy to park and walk to campus and avoid traffic and congestion. The busiest time is 8:00-8:45am so you might consider a later visit, too.

Open House- Friday, August 26th from 8:30-11:00am

We are looking forward to starting the new school year and have been busy getting things ready! We will have many new students and their families joining our school family to learn from our exciting IB/PYP program.

1st-5th grade class rosters will be posted on the front windows on Thursday, August 25th at 4:30pm. Open House is scheduled for Friday, August 26th from 8:30am-11:00am to meet your teacher and complete many beginning of the year procedures and processes. The 2016-17 school year will begin for students in grades 1st through 5th on Monday, August 29, 2016.

Kindergarten parents should attend one of the Parent Orientation sessions offered on Aug. 26th (8:45am or 10:15am) and complete beginning of the year materials during Open House. Kindergarten students staggered entry will be from Aug 29-Sept. 1. Kindergarten class rosters will be posted on Sept. 2 at 12:45pm and Kindergarten Open House is Friday, Sept. 2nd from 1:00-2:00pm.

With about 800 students, cooperation from all families is appreciated in using good neighbor judgment when parking on campus and in our neighborhood during our Open House event.



Taking care of Starting the Year Business at Open House...

In addition to seeing friends, making new ones and meeting your teacher; Open House is time to get all of the starting school business completed:

- **PTA Membership** information and on line registration information is included with this newsletter. At Open House, sign up for the many volunteer opportunities through the PTA.
- **FWES Spiritwear** will be on sale at Open House. Many shirts will be available to take home that day!
- **Agendas:** Each 2nd-5th Grade student will need to purchase an agenda for \$3.00 each- look for the table near PTA.
- **Carpool tag** registration forms are available on our website to complete and bring with you and will also be available

for families during Open House. All families who use carpool must register for a NEW number each year to insure student safety at dismissal.

- **Bus route information** will be posted on line for families to review. All NEW riders must register for a bus route before they will be allowed to ride a bus. You can register at [Bus Rider Registration](#). More information is included on page 2.
- **Volunteer registration** will be available at Open House- sign up (or reactivate) to be a volunteer at FWES!
- **Before/After School Care** information is available on the

school website. Completed forms and payment will begin being accepted in the Main Office on Monday, August 15th for the 2016-17 school year. Families may also sign up at Open House, but are encouraged to print and fill out all forms at home and bring them to Open House. Payment is required to be enrolled.

- **Lunch Account** information will be available and families can put an initial amount on the child's lunch account to start the year.
- **Medications can be signed in** at the Main Office. Remember that the 1702 form must be completed by your physician and the medication must be in its prescription container before we can sign for it at the school.

Kindergarten Student Staggered Entry

Kindergarten students have received information regarding staggered entry: Aug. 29 A-D; Aug. 30 E-K; Aug. 31 L-R; Sept. 1 S-Z. 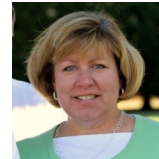
From Mrs. Pierce...

- **PTA Thank You!** Our PTA's fund raising efforts the last several years allowed for the resurfacing and finishing of our new "Green Top" play area for our students. The new surface will provide students with a much smoother area for play. Thank you for your continued support of PTA fund raising so that projects such as this one can continue at FWES!
- **Bus Routes for 2016-17:** All bus routes, stops and times will be available at www.wcpss.net the week of August 22nd. The school will not have information until these routes are published.

• Students who have not regularly ridden a bus previously who want to ride the bus this year (even if not daily) must register as a bus rider through the WCPSS website at: [Bus Rider Registration](#).

• **Curriculum Night 9/15:** The school staff is excited to welcome all parents to a Curriculum and Information Night on September 15th; K-2 from 5:30-6:30pm; 3-5 from 6:30-7:30pm. The evening will provide families with information about the curriculum standards from your child's grade level team and the classroom expectations and procedures from your child's teacher. All other specialists and special areas teachers will also be available that night to share information and answer questions. Please your calendar for this important parent learning night!



• **Carpool Process:** The carpool process at FWES provides a safe way for students to be picked up each afternoon and takes about 20-25 minutes to load the 300+ cars that come through the lane each day. Please note, however, that the first 2-4 weeks of school are when the process can take up to 40 minutes, as students are learning their new numbers and our new families and students are learning the process. Adults will **NOT** be allowed to check students out from the carpool holding area in the cafeteria if the child is registered as a carpooler. Please be patient and remain in line in your car until your student can be loaded safely.

• **Carpool Tags:** Students are issued NEW numbers each year- so all families will need to complete a carpool registration form to get carpool tags at Open House. Families without 2016-17 school issued carpool tags displayed will have to pull over and sign the child out in

the office after showing proper identification.

- **Walker Dismissal Reminders:** Our school has increased the number of students dismissed as walkers the last few years. This increase has put an extreme strain on available parking and on our relationship with the Kildare Farm community. Please note that families who choose to drive to our school to meet "walkers" at the front entrance for dismissal should be respectful of the school's neighbors if you park in the neighborhood. For the safety of all pedestrians, those waiting to meet students at the front of the school will be asked to leave the area as soon as your child has been picked up so that carpool may begin to flow quickly and safely. Safety patrol will ring a triangle to notify the front porch that carpool is beginning and school staff will ask any remaining families to move down the sidewalk. In addition, families wishing to stay and play with friends will need to use the K-1 playground by the villas as the front playground is not be available during dismissal. More information is available on the school website and will be sent home the first week of school. Thank you for your cooperation!
- **Instructional Assistants:** Due to changes in state funding and regulations, the instructional assistants at FWES will be used across grade levels in the 16-17 school year to assist all classrooms with instructional needs. The first month of school will have Instructional Assistants (IAs) full time in kindergarten classrooms for transition and some assistant support in 1st-3rd grades. Beginning October 1st, IAs will be shared to support literacy instruction in K/1 and 2/3 classrooms, and one IA will also be assigned to support instructional needs in 4/5. FWES School Improvement Plan 2016-18

The School Improvement Plan (SIP) is a document that guides the work of our school community as we grow IB learners. Families are a vital part of the learning that occurs at Farmington Woods. All members of the School Improvement Team, staff and parents, must be voted in to represent their respective groups. Once your interest is expressed, your name will be shared with our PTA and the PTA will present you for a vote to serve at the PTA Meeting on September 15th. Important Updates and Changes for 16-17...

Please see the [Parent Handbook 2016-17](#) for additional information on the brief notes below:

- ⇒ Breakfast and Lunch Prices have increased by \$.25- Breakfast \$1.25 and Lunch \$2.25 per meal
- ⇒ All 2nd-5th Graders will need to pay \$3 for the school agenda to the Farmington Woods PTA- bring payment to Open House on 8/26.
- ⇒ Due to new health/medical mandates, Field Trip permission slips must be returned at least 30 days prior to the field trip.
- ⇒ Clubs have been moved from Wednesdays to Thursdays for 2016-17
- ⇒ [Healthy Active Students](#) guidelines make healthy snacks (pretzels, lowfat yogurt, fresh fruits and vegetables, graham crackers, etc.) a priority in the classroom when students bring a snack from home. Students will be limited to 2 snack purchases in the cafeteria for eating with lunch. Birthday recognitions should not include high sugar snacks and families are encouraged to celebrate with other options - if a snack is shared during lunch in the cafeteria, healthy snacks or bite-sized cupcakes/brownies/cookies are appropriate options.
- ⇒ Last minute transportation changes made in person after 3:15pm at the front office are reserved for emergencies or unique situations and should not occur regularly.
- ⇒ Walkers should exit campus by 3:50pm daily. Parents unable to meet students by 3:50pm will need to register and pick up students in the carpool line.
- ⇒ Classroom Instructional time is a priority. Classroom interruptions will be eliminated throughout the day for delivery of forgotten items - teachers will have notes in their mailboxes about items dropped off and students may pickup forgotten items during their lunch time. Please remind students to bring homework, projects, jackets, etc. each morning.
- ⇒ WCPSS Dress Code applies to all K-12 students. Back to school reminders for our students: sundresses/halter style shirts must be worn over a t-shirt or with a sweater; shorts/skirts must be fingertip length; sagging pants, spaghetti straps, excessively tight clothing, bare midribs and exposed undergarments are not allowed. Due to daily physical activity, for student safety, flip flops should not be worn to school. Thank you for monitoring your child's dress each day to check for dress code compliance- especially in the warmer weeks at the start of the year!

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Continuing A Walk in the Woods ...

- **Scheduling Specials:** We will continue with the 7 day rotation of 45 minute specials with classes visiting one special class at the same time each day: Art, Music, PE, Science, Technology and 2 Language (Spanish K-2; Spanish or Mandarin 3-5).
- **Before/After School Applications:** We will begin accepting applications for Before/After School care for the 16-17 school year on Monday, August 15th in the main office. Due to required student/staff ratios, there are limited seats available in both programs. To begin the year, there will be 100 seats available in each program. Registration payment of \$15 and all completed paperwork is required for a students' registration to be processed and a student to be enrolled. Forms are available on the school website for completion prior to bringing them to school on or after August 15th.
- **On Line Lunch Account:** Wake County Child Nutrition Services offers all families the option to pay on student lunch accounts through www.myschoolbucks.com. Using this service allows parents to pay with credit cards and access information about the purchases your child makes each day. It also sends email alerts when your child's lunch account gets below \$5.00. The system has been upgraded from last year's mylunchmoney.com so look for the change when you log on, but your log in and password are the same.
- **Volunteer Registration:**
Registration is available on any WCPSS computer from July 1st-October 30th 24 hrs a day. Beginning Nov. 1st registration is only available on Mondays from 8:00am-4:00pm. Volunteers may register in the school office- registration is open now when the school is open.
- * **Returning Registered Volunteers-** Returning volunteers must reactivate his/her file through a simple process to remain on the approved volunteer list. Reactivation can be completed on a school computer. Those not reactivated by October 30th will be dropped from the approved list and will have to complete the new volunteer process to return to the list.
- * **Approved Volunteers New to FWES-** We welcome our new families. If you were an approved volunteer at another Wake County school in the 15-16 school year, you will need to re-activate your volunteer registration *as soon as possible* and make changes to your school list to include FWES- so that your clearance appears on our school approval list. This reactivation and verification of your status on the FWES list, will be required prior to volunteering in our school.
- * **New Volunteers:** All new volunteers to FWES are required to register and have a background check completed prior to volunteering. Background checks can take up to two weeks to be returned so new volunteers should register as soon as possible.
- **Safety Patrol Sign up:** 4th and 5th grade students interested in serving on our Safety Patrol for the 16-17 school year can sign up at the Safety Patrol table during Open House. Many students are needed to assist in the mornings and afternoons with carpool.
