

Fifth Grade Talent Show



The Fifth Grade Talent Show will be held on Tues., June 6, 2017, in the cafetorium. Two performances will be presented, at 9:30-10:15 am (K-2nd grade audience) and 10:30-11:15 am (3rd-5th grade audience). Participation is voluntary and family and friends are invited to attend.

Auditions are on the following dates from 9:25-10:10am.

Solo acts are acceptable, but groups of several students are encouraged to allow participation by many students. Groups can include members of any fifth grade class. They should audition during the time that contains the majority of performers. All acts should be kept to less than three minutes. Due to the 45-minute program time limit, the number of accepted groups will be limited. Overall times of each act may be shortened slightly to provide time for as many to perform as possible.

A variety of talent entries, such as sports, music, dance, comedy, etc, makes up the best show. Talents that cannot be demonstrated at school, such as skateboarding, ice skating or horseback riding, may be videotaped. All actions, words, and costumes must be appropriate and in good taste, meeting the guidelines of WCPSS. Students who sing with a CD must sing, not lip-sync. Singers (or someone from their group) must submit lyrics with their audition form. Karaoke recordings are highly encouraged, but not required.

Auditions may be recorded and should be polished performances. Props should be brought to the audition, such as instruments, accompaniment music, CDs, jump ropes, etc. Students may use the CD player and the keyboard in the music room; both will be available for use at the show, as well as a microphone. Please speak to Miss Vitullo or the fifth grade teachers regarding any special needs, circumstances, or questions. This is your show, and we want to accommodate as many different kinds of talent as possible.
