

SSA – Single Subject Acceleration

Students meeting qualifying criteria in can take advanced academic content in mathematics or English Language Arts through SSA. This ensures opportunities for appropriate levels of academic challenge.

SSA allows students to show mastery of content in select elementary or middle school courses. Students who prove mastery do not have to take the course and may move on to the next level.

Parents may nominate their child to skip a grade level of content in **either** English Language Arts or mathematics.

Students are nominated for SSA by their parents or guardians. They will be assessed based upon grade level. Depending on grade level and subject, this could include a multiple-choice test and/or a writing sample.
