



End of Grade Testing Reminders...

EOG Testing Schedule

All initial test sessions are 180 minutes long, however students may take up to 240 minutes if needed. Free breakfast for those testing is available on each testing morning in the café.

Friday, May 26 EOG English Language Arts (reading) 9:15am-1:15pm

Tuesday, May 30 EOG Math (calculator inactive and active) 9:15am-1:15pm

Wednesday, May 31 EOG 5th Grade Science 9:15am-1:15pm

Students should arrive by 9:05am to have time to prepare for testing. Students who arrive after the 9:15am tardy bell will NOT be admitted to the classroom and will have to participate another day in a make up testing session as once official testing sessions begin, they may not be interrupted. All 3rd-5th Graders MUST be in classrooms and *ready to begin testing at 9:20am.*

Materials for EOG Testing Days

- **Phones, Electronic Devices, Fidget Spinners:** Students should NOT bring any phones or electronic devices to school on EOG testing days. Any rings or noises that may interrupt the testing session could result in a misadministration, causing students in the classroom to have to retake the test. Students may have no items with them during the EOG except approved testing materials- fidget spinners and such items must remain in book bags.
- **Approved Book to Read:** Students may have one book to read if they finish testing before the end of the session. All books must be reviewed and approved by the teacher the *day before testing* and remain in the classroom overnight. Please have the book selection ready for your child's teacher to review on Thursday, May 25th and the book will remain at school until the end of the day Tuesday. 5th Graders should have books for the Science EOG at school on Wednesday, May 31st for approval.
- **Bring Water Bottle:** Students may have a water bottle available during the testing session. All water bottles should have a lid that closes and will be kept on the floor beside the child's testing seat during testing. Water bottles will be accessible when students stand to take quiet breaks during testing. Students will not be allowed to refill water bottles during testing or have water on or near test materials.
- **Testing Materials will be Provided:** Pencils, scrap paper and approved calculators for students to use while testing will be provided in the classroom. Students need no other materials from home for testing. This includes fidget spinners. These are not allowed during testing unless there is a legal accommodation in place.



Other EOG Information

- **Lunch Schedule:** Lunch schedules will be determined each day when all testing is completed and test materials counted and collected. Due to the unknown lunch schedule, no visitors will be allowed for lunch on EOG testing days K-5.
- **Classroom Early Check Out:** Students may NOT be released from the classroom during a testing session. Please check all appointment schedules for your child. It is safe to assume that most students (unless they required extra time to complete the test) will be available for dismissal by 1:30pm. Those who required extra time may not be dismissed until they reach the 240 minutes or complete the test.
