PTA Year End Report 2015-2016

- The Go, Play, Save Fundraiser earned over \$8,235
- Our fifth annual Boosterthon Fun Run earned \$17.675
- By clipping Box Tops and Labels for Education, the PTA earned approximately \$2,335
- Students enjoyed 4 cultural arts performances including Digeridoo Down Under and a writer-in-residence, Michael Beadle, who worked with all classes.
- The mini grant program provided many new useful learning tools for our school and classrooms including: Geocache GPS kits; I-pads for the Inquiry Center; Reading Comprehension & Speech Therapy tools; 3-D Geometry Shapes; & Spanish curriculum games & kits
- Teachers received \$50 classroom start-up funds.
- The PTA was able to provide Scholastic News as a source of non-fiction reading material for all classrooms. We were also able to provide funding for agendas for students in grades 2nd-5th!
- After fundraising efforts and saving for a few years we were FINALLY able to get a resurfaced black top!! We are excited for you to check it out this year!
