# **EOG Testing Schedule**

All test sessions are 180 minutes long

Friday, May 26 EOG 3rd-5th English Language Arts (reading) 9:20am-1:15pm

Tuesday, May 30 EOG 3rd-5th Math (calculator inactive and active) 9:20am-1:15pm

Wednesday, May 31 EOG 5th Grade Science 9:20am-1:15pm

K-5 students should work to arrive on time, preferably by 9:05am. K-2 Students arriving after testing has started will have wait in the office until they can be escorted to the classroom. 3-5 students arriving after testing has started will have to remain in the office until it is completed and participate on an EOG re-testing day.

# **Schedule Changes in the Building**

State required EOG testing of 3rd-5th graders requires very clear environmental expectations. These expectations will require schedule changes for the entire school community and your cooperation is appreciated. If your child struggles with changes in schedules, please monitor your child's teacher communication for information you can discuss with your child to prepare them for the three days.

• No Visitors for Lunch: K-2 students will eat lunch in the classrooms during EOG so no visitors may join them on any testing day. 3-5 students will have varying lunch times each EOG day depending on when all classes have finished testing, therefore there is no way to predict when classes will be going to the cafeteria for lunch.

Note: There are many other dates the last 2 weeks of school when there are changes in the lunch schedule. Please check with your child's teacher or the Google calendar on the website for events.

## No movement in the building:

- Please note that all volunteers are needed to assist with EOG testing or K-2 lunch delivery. No additional volunteers will be allowed to enter the building during EOG testing for work in the workroom, PTA closet or classrooms.
- Left items will not be able to be delivered to classrooms or retrieved from the office until after testing. Please make sure your child has all of his/her belongings when they arrive at school in the morning.

### • Appointments or Check Outs from School:

• Please work to avoid appointments where students need to arrive late or leave school prior to 2:00pm on EOG testing days due to the changes in schedules and need to maintain a secure testing environment
