Advanced Placement (AP) Exam Registration

AP Exam registration begins on February 1 and ends on February 24. Register now. Late registrations will not be accepted. Follow the registration directions on the website. Payments/forms must be dropped in Student Services before school, after school or during lunch only. Students should register here. Students must register for each exam they will take. Fees will be waived for courses offered and taken at LRHS. Students must pay the \$93 exam fee for courses not taught taken at LRHS. Student Services Updates

Updated GPA and Rank: Updated GPA and Rank will be available on Thursday, February 9. Seniors should not request a new transcript before this date.

Midyear Transcripts: Most colleges do not require or ask for an updated transcript, however...

- If seniors need a midyear transcript sent to a college or university in North Carolina that does NOT use the Common Application Program, they will need to complete a Release of Information Form in the Student Services Office. If they are under 18, they will have to take it home, have their parents sign the form and bring it back.
- CFNC does not update transcripts at the midyear (a transcript that includes first semester grades and new class rank). This is why the midyear transcript must be sent from our office and not requested through CFNC.
- If seniors have already completed a Release of Information Form this year, they can come to Student Services and ask to add a midyear transcript request to the already completed form.
- If the college or university is asking for a midyear transcript and uses the Common Application Program, seniors must email their assigned counselor to let them know. The counselor will then use the Common Application program to upload and send an updated transcript.
- Many colleges and universities ask that seniors self-report 1st semester grades. If this is the case, then seniors would not need to request a transcript as their grades will be on their report card and can be viewed in PowerSchool.
- If the college or university needs an updated transcript and is outside of North Carolina, seniors should continue to use the SCRIBORDER Website: https://wcpss.scriborder.com/

Seniors Who Still Need To Apply For The First Time or Have No Definite Plans:

- If a senior has not yet applied to college or has no definite plans, please have them contact their counselor. The counselors can help direct them in the next steps to take.
