Human Trafficking Curriculum

NC Senate Bill 279 mandates that all students in grades 7-9 receive instruction concerning human trafficking prevention and awareness. All WCPSS students currently enrolled in a Healthful Living class will participate in a lesson on Human Trafficking, presented by members of the Student Services staff. For the ninth grade curriculum, students will learn the following objective: Grade 9 - 9.ICR.1.5: Explain how power and control in relationships can contribute to aggression, violence, and human trafficking.

The students will watch a video, followed by a lesson on healthy relationships. Students will then participate in a survey to help staff identify high-risk pupils and refer them to assistance resources.
