Telephone Transition

As required by WCPSS, our phone system has transitioned to the new system. The main office number is still the same at 919-870-4250, but now you will select 1 of 3 options: 1 for Student Services, 2 for attendance, or 0 for the operator. The operator is the main desk. All other phone numbers have now reverted to extensions. If you know your party's extension, you can dial it when you hear the recording.

Our personalized greeting, with inclement weather messages when appropriate, can be heard when you press 0 on days the school is closed.

Health Assessment Form and Immunizations

North Carolina public school attendance laws require that parents/legal guardians provide to the school, within 30 days of their child's first day of attendance:

- 1) An immunization record documenting all required immunizations
- 2) A physical completed within one calendar year prior to the date of attendance, if your child has never attended a school in North Carolina

While almost all families have provided this information, some have not. Beginning Monday, October 24 students who have not provided this information will be excluded from school. These families will receive a separate phone message and their students received a letter on Friday, October 14.

Ticket to Play for Winter Sports
