Semester 1 Exams

Semester 1 Exams will be held from Wednesday, January 18 through Monday, January 23. Tuesday January 24 is an exam make-up day. We will send our detailed exam schedule out in December. Specific information about which exams will be held on which days is now posted on our website calendar.

North Carolina Final Exams (NCFE)

For the 2016-17 school year, state-wide North Carolina Final Exams (NCFE) are being re-instated for the following courses: Civics, World History, American History I and II, Physical Science, Earth Science, Chemistry, Physics, Math II, Math III, Advanced Functions & Modeling, Discrete Math, Pre-Calculus, English I, English III, and English IV. As with all other final exams, the NCFEs are worth 20% of a student's final grade. Seniors cannot be exempted from NCFEs.

NC implemented new standards this year for Math 2 and Math 3. The NCFE has not been field tested on students, so the results cannot be used as final exam grades for students. All Math 2 and Math 3 students will take an NCFE for the course they are enrolled in, but their semester average will be based entirely on the average of their two quarter grades. Each quarter grade will be 50% of the final course grade.

Two-hour Delay on Tuesday, November 8

Please be aware that all Wake County schools will open on a two-hour delay Tuesday, November 8 because of the anticipated high traffic on Election Day. School buses will pick up students two hours later than their regular daily schedule. Our two-hour delay schedule is:

Credit by Demonstrated Mastery

Students may earn high school credit for specified courses without spending a set number of hours taking the course in a classroom. Under the state's Credit by Demonstrated Mastery (CDM) option, uniquely qualified students may "test out" or bypass a course if they have already mastered the content.
