College Admission Deadlines and Transcript Requests

Reminder for seniors! Many colleges have January deadlines, so seniors should be working on applications. If they need to make any requests for recommendations or transcripts, those requests should be made ASAP before the winter break. Requests for transcripts will not be processed over the winter break, December 22 until January 3.

PSAT Results

Students who took the PSAT in October received a hard copy of their test results the week of December 12th through their 1st period teacher. Students who provided their email address on their PSAT answer sheet should have received an email reminder from the CollegeBoard explaining where and how to view their scores online.

Students are encouraged to take advantage of the many resources on the CollegeBoard website, www.collegeboard.org, and to go ahead and set up a CollegeBoard account that they will use and reference throughout high school. Linking PSAT scores and future SAT scores, as well as accessing the KHAN Academy Tutorial helps to prepare for the SAT. Students can touch base with their counselor if they have questions.

Notes:

1. In the left column, CTE stands for Career & Technical Education.
2. All buses will run at 2:18 on exam days.
3. Students may leave campus at the conclusion of exams with a completed permission form signed by their parent(s). Once students leave campus for the day, they may not return.
4. Students remaining on campus after exams are to report to lunch and the designated class or area for the day.
5. All students should report to school on January 18 and January 19. On January 20 and 23, **only** students with a scheduled EOC should report to campus.
6. Students should speak with their math teacher if they are unclear on which day they should take the Math I EOC.
7. Make-up exams will be administered by appointment with the teacher.
8. Students must be present at the beginning of each exam period to take the exam. Students must be present for the entire exam period to receive credit for the exam.
9. Students who are on campus during an exam period for which they do not have an exam or scheduled review session must report to Student Services.
10. The campuses of Leesville Road Elementary School and Leesville Road Middle School, as well as other Wake County schools, are strictly off limits on these dates to Leesville Road High School students.
11. **In all courses with an End-of-Course (EOC) test, North Carolina Final Exam (NCFE), or Teacher-Made Exam, the test shall count as 20% of the student's final grade. The only exception is Math II and III NCFEs, which are in a pilot year and will not be used as part of the student's course average.**
