Notes:

- 1. In the left column, CTE stands for Career & Technical Education.
- 2. All buses will run at 2:18 on exam days.
- 3. Students may leave campus at the conclusion of exams with a completed permission form signed by their parent(s). Once students leave campus for the day, they may not return.
- 4. Students remaining on campus after exams are to report to lunch and the designated class or area for the day.
- 5. All students should report to school on January 18 and January 19. On January 20 and 23, **only** students with a scheduled EOC should report to campus.
- 6. Students should speak with their math teacher if they are unclear on which day they should take the Math I EOC.
- 7. Make-up exams will be administered by appointment with the teacher.
- 8. Students must be present at the beginning of each exam period to take the exam. Students must be present for the entire exam period to receive credit for the exam.
- 9. Students who are on campus during an exam period for which they do not have an exam or scheduled review session must report to Student Services.
- 10. The campuses of Leesville Road Elementary School and Leesville Road Middle School, as well as other Wake County schools, are strictly off limits on these dates to Leesville Road High School students.
- 11. In all courses with an End-of-Course (EOC) test, North Carolina Final Exam (NCFE), or Teacher-Made Exam, the test shall count as 20% of the student's final grade. The only exception is Math II and III NCFEs, which are in a pilot year and will not be used as part of the student's course average.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Each year we make every effort to include all students in the end-of-grade and end-of-course test administrations. This is important to ensure all students have information on their achievement and their growth for the school year. Including all students is also necessary for school accountability reports to accurately reflect the performance of the school as a whole. To ensure all students are tested, North Carolina tracks student participation rates for schools. In situations where a school did not test at least 95 percent of its student population or of its identified subgroups, that information is reported on the READY Accountability Reporting website at http://www.ncpublicschools.org/accountability/reporting/. This letter is to inform you that Leesville Road High did not meet the 95 percent testing participation rate requirement for either the school as a whole or for a subgroup(s) for the 2015-16 school year. The targets missed include:

MathHispanicReadingStudents with Disabilities

As a result of falling below the testing participation requirement, Leesville Road High has created a plan of action to ensure that moving forward there will be full participation from all subgroups at our school. To help ensure that we meet our test participation targets this year, several strategies will be put in place, including:

- Phone calls to students' homes reminding them of testing schedules and dates;
- Ensuring that students who are not in school on the day of testing are contacted to schedule a makeup test;
- Providing more testing options for students who are not attending school because of suspensions or placement in a home hospital setting; and
- Posting exam schedules online

A consecuencia de caer por debajo del requisito de participación de los exámenes, Leesville Road High ha creado un plan de acción para asegurar que en el futuro habrá una participación plena por parte de todos los subgrupos en nuestra escuela.
