### Second Semester

The second semester begins on Wednesday, January 20. Students will report to their 1<sup>st</sup> semester period 1 class for approximately 5 minutes. They will receive their second semester class schedule, then transition to their 2<sup>nd</sup> semester period 1 class. Second semester schedules are viewable through HomeBase/PowerSchool as well. Our Second Semester Open House will be held on Thursday, January 21 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. An agenda is included with the bulletin. Parents need to know and report to their student's 1<sup>st</sup> period class where schedules will be distributed for the remainder of the evening. 1<sup>st</sup> period classes will also be posted in the cafeteria, outside student services, and outside the multipurpose room in the Murphy Building.

### College Planning Night and College Fair - January 26, 2016

The PTSA is hosting a College Planning Night and College Fair on January 26 at 6:30 p.m. in the auditorium. The night will include presentations on SAT/ACT preparation (including information on the new SAT format), how to select a college, college financial aid as well as a College Fair with representatives from over 40 colleges, universities and other organizations. Participating organizations include Duke University, University of Alabama, Watts School of Nursing, Meredith College, Shaw University, East Carolina University, and all branches of the armed forces. This is your opportunity to speak directly with representatives about college entrance requirements, college majors, residence hall requirements, honors colleges, and other relevant college information.

### “Ticket to Play” and Tryouts for Spring Sports

Tryouts for spring sports will begin on February 15 (specific times and locations will be communicated closer to tryouts). “Ticket to Play” for spring sports will be held in room 1301 during lunches from Monday, February 1 through Wednesday, February 3. In order for students to try out for athletic teams, they must have a “Ticket to Play” to ensure proper eligibility. Prior to receiving a ticket to play, athletes must complete all nine pages of the WCPSS/LRHS Athletic Participation Forms. Part of this packet requires all athletes to have a completed physical exam form. The physical exam must be current within one year of tryouts and athletic participation.
