For Current 9th - 11th Grade Parents:

"Ticket to Play" and Tryouts for Spring Sports

Tryouts for spring sports will begin on February 15 (specific times and locations will be communicated closer to tryouts). "Ticket to Play" for spring sports will be held in room 1301 during lunches from Monday, February 1 through Wednesday, February 3. In order for students to try out for athletic teams, they must have a "Ticket to Play" to ensure proper eligibility. Prior to receiving a ticket to play, athletes must complete all nine pages of the WCPSS/LRHS Athletic Participation Forms. Part of this packet requires all athletes to have a completed physical exam form. The physical exam must be current within one year of tryouts and athletic participation. Student Services Updates

A new class rank will be done on February 3. You will need to request transcripts after this date.

If seniors need to send a midyear transcript to any college or university, they will need to complete a Release of Records form. This form can be found on the school's website under forms or picked up in the Student Services Office. Once complete, they should submit the request form to student services, and an updated transcript will be mailed. Seniors should not use CFNC or the online SCRIB program for midyear requests.

Counselors will begin meeting with students on February 16 to start the class registration process for the 2016-2017 school year. Students will receive an updated transcript, a graduation credit check sheet and a class list along with other pertinent information.

Juniors will bring this information home in a green folder, sophomores in a red folder and freshmen in a yellow folder. Please talk with your student about the information in their folder. If you then have questions, please email your student's assigned counselor.
