Start-on-Time

Our Start-on-Time process will begin this Tuesday morning. Students who are not in their classrooms by the bell each period will be issued a pass to class and assigned a lunch detention the following day. The only excused tardies are those specifically stated by WCPSS policy. Examples include illness or injury and appointment with a health care provider. Oversleeping or car trouble are not reasons for an excused tardy or absence. Students accumulate more tardies to 1st period than any other period in the day. Please help us by ensuring your student gets on the bus or arrives in carpool in enough time to report to 1st period by 7:25. End-of-Course Exams (EOCs) Weight Change

We just received word that beginning with this school year, End-of-Course Exams (EOCs) will count for 20% of a student's final semester grade (instead of the previous 25%). Biology, English II, and NC Math IB/NC Math I are the only courses impacted. Since this is a late change, you may see documents such as handbooks and syllabi that have incorrect information.

Preliminary Scholastic Aptitude Test (PSAT)

LRHS will administer the PSAT to interested students on Saturday, October 15 at 8:00 a.m. Students will be best prepared for this test if they have successfully completed Math I. Due to National Merit Scholarship opportunities, students with a GPA of 4.5625 or higher will have their registration fee waived. Any student who wishes to take the test (even those who will have their fee waived) must register in Student Services before school or during lunch by September 16. 

Students and Parents:

Leesville Road High School will offer the PSAT on Saturday, Oct. 15 at 8 a.m. Any student may register to take the PSAT.

The PSAT is a standardized, multiple-choice test that includes three sections: critical reading, mathematics and writing. The test provides practice for the SAT and offers insight for advising and counseling students. Students will be best prepared for this test if they have successfully completed Math I.

The deadline to register for the PSAT test is Friday, September 16. Students must register by the deadline to be allowed to take the PSAT (no exceptions). Your child must register in Student Services *before school or during lunch only*. There is an administration fee of \$15 that is due upon registration (exact change or check to LRHS).

The PSAT allows 11th grade students the opportunity to potentially qualify for a National Merit scholarship if they receive a very high score (generally the top 1%). For this reason, WCPSS is offering the test free of charge to 11th grade students with a 4.5625 GPA or higher, as we do not want to deny any student who might be competitive for that program the opportunity to take the test due to the inability to pay. Student Services can tell your student whether or not he or she qualifies. Fee waivers are also available for students based on financial need. Juniors who will be able to take the PSAT without cost due to their GPA must also register by September 16.
