

MCHS Optional AP Chemistry Boot Camp



<u>Purpose:</u> Help students review concepts learned in Honors Chemistry so that all MCHS Students who are taking AP Chemistry will feel ready when school begins.

<u>**Rationale:**</u> Some students have had a whole school year between Honors Chemistry and AP Chemistry and likely have forgotten a lot. I would like to help them "catch" back up.

<u>Summer Assignment</u>: Has been posted on the school website and covers what I expect students to know when they arrive on the first day of school. If the accompanying videos and the review problems are not enough of a review, I want the students to have an opportunity to meet with me and review in person.

When & Where: We will meet August 7-11 in room 2200 from 9am-12pm.

<u>Agenda:</u> We will review the concepts in the review packets of the summer assignment and review some labs from honors chemistry. There are labs that I want to make sure students remember from Honors Chemistry when I refer to them in class, but we will not have time during class to perform them again.
