**GLOBAL POINTS OF PROGRESS** – Georgia: Rare sea turtles have made a coastal comeback. Citing a strong nesting season on southern Atlantic beaches, state wildlife officials said they have counted more than 2,890 loggerhead nests so far this summer. That's a new record for Georgia, and a number that surpasses the state's long-term recovery goal for the species.
