Math Calculator Information TI-84+ Calculator

After consultation with Green Hope High School, the Davis Drive Math Department has determined that students in middle school would benefit greatly from the use of a TI-84+ calculator. Therefore, students need to bring a TI-84+ calculator to class each day. This practice will assist students' transition to high school. In addition, these calculators will be used by the students as they advance through their math courses in high school. This calculator is also approved for use on the Math EOGs, CCM1 EOCs, CCM2 EOCs, MSLs, AP Exams, SAT, and ACT. We understand that the purchase is an investment; however, many students use their calculators into college. (We strongly discourage the use of sharing calculators with a sibling.)
