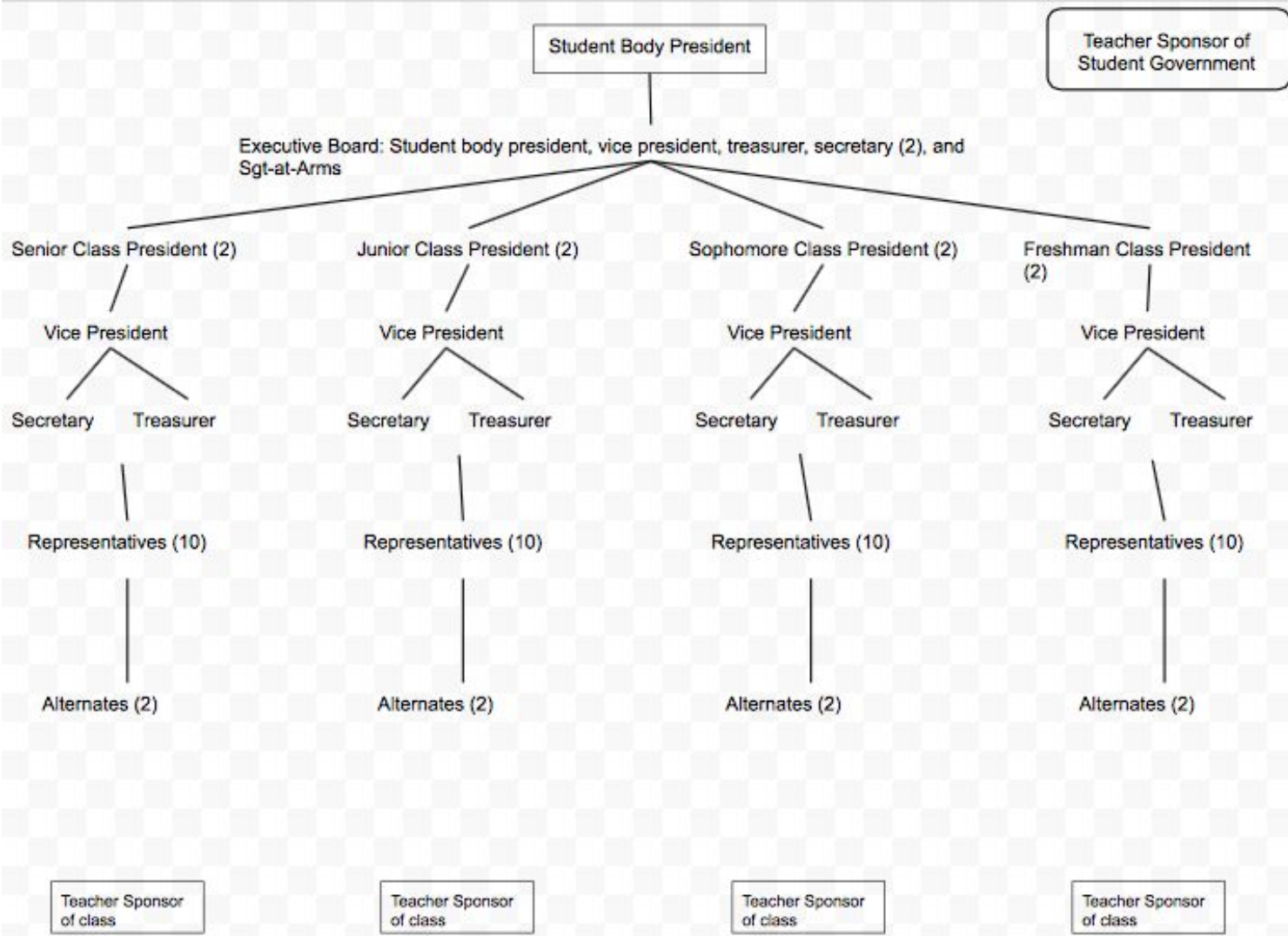

Student Government Interest Meeting

ARTICLE IV ELECTION OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OFFICERS

Sec. 1 The President must be a senior who has served on Student Government for at least one year.

Sec. 2 The Vice-President must be a junior who has served on the Student Government for at least one year.

Sec. 3 The Co-Secretary offices and the office of Treasurer may be held by sophomore, junior, or senior representatives.

Sec. 4 The office of Sergeant-at-Arms must be a sophomore.
