General Election Guidelines:

- 1. Campaigning may begin as soon as intent to run forms have been turned in.
- 2. No one may give out candy or gifts in exchange for votes. (The only acceptable items will be printed information about the candidate.)
- 3. Posters should be appropriate and positive, and should not demean another candidate.
- 4. Posters should not be hung over existing artwork.
- 5. Posters belonging to other candidates should not be taken down.
- 6. Posters should be removed within 2 days of the election.
- 7. No campaign stickers are allowed.
- 8. Candidates may not stand near the voting table.
- 9. Candidates may not miss class to campaign.
- 10. Candidates should encourage students to go vote during their lunch outside of the cafeteria.

- **Tuesday, September 5th: Freshman intent-to-run forms are due to Mrs. Cottengim in room 3462 on south campus, to Mrs. Ortiz at the 9th grade center in room N401, or in the front office of the 9th grade center by 2:30.
- **Thursday, September 7th: Candidates should have already had speeches approved and should ride the after school activity bus to south campus and report to room 2322 beside the media center. Mr Boyette will tape your speech and put it up so that it can be viewed on Monday, September 11th.
- **Monday, September 11th: Freshmen watch speeches in 1st block. Students will vote throughout the day on Monday.
