<a href="#">Blackboard</a>	E,M,H	Teachers can store, arrange, and present content that can be accessed by students.	Blackboard administrator at your school can help you log in.	All students and teachers have an account.	App version works best for smartphones/ipods and tablets.
<a href="#">Edmodo</a>	E,M,H	Teachers can store, arrange, and present content that can be accessed by students.	Teacher or student can create an account using WCPSS credentials.	All students must have parent signature to create an account.	App version works best for smartphones/ipods and tablets.
<a href="#">EdPuzzle</a>	M,H	Overlay videos (from YouTube, TED, Khan etc.) with notes, and formative assessments.	Teachers can create account on website.	Students do not need account to view videos created by teachers.	App available for phones/tablets, also can be added as an app in Edmodo

<a href="#">Educreations</a>	E,M,H	Teachers create and share videos that can be accessed by students 24/7.	Teachers can create their own accounts on Educreations website.	Teachers can share their Educreations with students on any level but students under 13 need a parent signature to create accounts.	Need app for smartphone and tablet but teachers can also embed their Educreations in blog /website /google doc
<a href="#">Nearpod</a>	E,M,H	Teachers can choose lessons from the existing library or create their own by importing existing presentations. Teachers control the rate at which students experience content.	Teachers can create their own accounts on Nearpod website. Students only need a teacher provided code to access content.	Students under 13 must have parent or guardian permission to create their own account (no account necessary for access teacher presentations)	App version preferable, web browser works on all other devices.
<a href="#">Prezi</a>	E,M,H	Teachers create dynamic arrangements of content, YouTube videos, images, etc. that can be shared with students.	Teachers can create their own accounts on Prezi website.	Teachers can share their Prezi's with students on any level but students under 13 MUST NOT create accounts.	Need app for tablets, ipod, smartphone
<a href="#">Symbaloo</a>	E,M,H	Teachers organize & share websites with students	Teachers create own account and share link via LMS or website	No student account needed	Browser based on laptop and other devices
<a href="#">WCPSS Google Apps</a>	E, M, H	Create documents and presentations to be shared with students who in turn take notes and add comments directly in the materials. Access or create	use Lotus Notes login information	All teachers must use their WCPSS accounts. Students do not yet have accounts.	Students can access and view Google Docs and Presentations on all devices though they may be easier to read on a laptop.
