Thank you to all of our families for all that you do to help carpool work so efficiently! As the year continues, we wanted to extend a few general reminders to help keep it running as smoothly and as safely as possible.

- As you're approaching the carpool awning please pull all the way forward to the front of the awning, or all the way up to the car in front of you.
- Please pay careful attention to Officer Tew's directions as you exit campus.
- Please refrain from cell phone use while you're moving through the carpool line. Texting, checking social media, etc. can cause distractions that could cause fender benders and we obviously want to keep all drivers and students as safe as possible.
- In the morning, students continue to do a great job of exiting vehicles independently. Please do not hesitate to roll down your window and communicate to a staff member if you have safety locks and need assistance with your student exiting your car.
- In the afternoon, our safety patrol students are doing an awesome job of assisting students as they enter your vehicle to head home. Please ensure the car door is closed and the safety patrol member has stepped back before pulling off.
- Please remember to have students exit and enter vehicles on the passenger side of your vehicle. We do not want adults or students to have to exit your car and/or move through traffic at any point during carpool.
- Finally, we ask that all cars remain in a single file line as you move through carpool. We need to keep one lane open in front of the school for cabs and vehicles that need to access the handicap parking spaces.
- Please remember to communicate transportation changes.
- Thanks again for all you do to keep our students safe!
