**GRADING INFORMATION:** As you are probably aware, Wake County Public School System (WCPSS) will be sending out new final Grading Guidelines for students in Grades Ninth, Tenth, and Eleventh Grades tomorrow, Tuesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>. While the information you will receive from WCPSS is comprehensive and explained in detail, I will be sharing information in tomorrow's special message about what it means for us at Athens Drive. **ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) EXAMS HAVE STARTED:** Please remember that AP Exams have started today and will run through Friday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>. AP Exams will be taken at home and students can visit the <u>College Board website</u> for details. ## ATHLETIC UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT COLLECTION TOMORROW, TUESDAY, MAY 12<sup>TH</sup>:

Please remember that we are hosting an Athletic Uniform and Equipment Collection tomorrow, Tuesday, May 12<sup>th</sup>, from 1:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. in front of Jaguar Stadium. We are asking that our student athletes drive-thru and return all uniforms, equipment, etc. that they may have that needs to be returned to the school. We are asking that our student athletes use the last entrance to our Stadium Parking Lot and pull around to the entrance to the stadium. We will have all our coaches there to collect uniforms and equipment from our student athletes. Student athletes will not need to leave their vehicles, as this will be a drive-thru event with coaches maintaining social distancing standards. **STUDENT PARKING REFUND INFORMATION DUE BY THIS FRIDAY, MAY 15<sup>TH</sup>:** Due to the Governor's Executive Order requiring our schools to close for the remainder of the school year, families will be given the option to request a refund for the unused portion of student Parking Permits. The refund amount will be \$60.00 to reimburse for 3 months of Remote Learning. Families will have the following options regarding this refund:

- 1. Allow the refund to carry over to the next school year (This does not guarantee a spot).
- 2. Receive a refund check.
- 3. Donate the \$60 refund to the Wake County Public School System (WCPSS).

**YEARBOOK, HONOR STOLES, HONOR CORDS DISTRIBUTION EVENT:** Once we have a date that we will receive our Yearbooks, we will be scheduling a Yearbook, Honor Stoles, and Honor Cords distribution. Please know that this date will most likely fall during the last week of May or the first week of June. As soon as we have finalized a date and time for this event, we will communicate to our school family.

**COLLECTING TEXTBOOKS, LIBRARY BOOKS, ETC. AND ALLOWING STUDENTS TO RETRIEVE ITEMS THEY HAVE AT SCHOOL:** Please know that WCPSS is working on processes for schools to follow to allow students to return textbooks, library books, etc. that belong to the school. In addition, WCPSS will also be giving us processes to follow to allow students one more opportunity for coming to school and collecting any items that are still here at school that belong to them. I will keep you posted as to when we will schedule this event.

SCHOOL CALENDAR FOR THE 2020 – 2021 SCHOOL YEAR: Please remember that the State Legislature decided last week that all Traditional Calendar schools will begin the 2020 – 2021 school year on Monday, August 17<sup>th</sup>, 2020. As you make plans for the summer and in August, please remember this new school start date. Please also know that for the 2020 – 2021 school year, school will end on June 11<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

BUS RIDER INFORMATION FOR THE 2020 – 2021 SCHOOL YEAR: Please know that Bus Rider registration opened today, Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup>. Students who rode a bus to school this year will be notified via School Messenger tomorrow, May 12<sup>th</sup>, about the process. Please understand that while we still do not know for sure the impact COVID-19 may have on our schedule for the coming school year, WCPSS still needs to begin the process of planning bus routes to accommodate our students. The biggest piece of information to remember is that if your student is eligible for Transportation to Athens Drive Magnet High School and will be riding the bus to Athens again next year, you do not need to do anything. However, if you need to update your bus service needs for the 2020 -2021 school year, please go to <a href="https://www.wcpss.net/busrider">www.wcpss.net/busrider</a> and let WCPSS know. Additionally, if your student is assigned to a bus but is not a bus rider, please submit the decline bus form at <a href="https://www.wcpss.net/declinebus">www.wcpss.net/declinebus</a> so that WCPSS has the most up-to-date information to plan routes. Finally, as you think about riding the bus, please know that WCPSS will assure student safety by taking all measures recommended by public health officials with regards to Bus Transportation.

REMINDER ANNOUNCEMENTS FROM PREVIOUS SPECIAL MESSAGES THAT I HAVE NOT UPDATED:

**SENIOR INTENT FORM—ALL SENIORS MUST COMPLETE THIS FORM!** All Seniors are required to complete a Senior Intent form before Graduation. The deadline has passed, and we have not received a form for

each Senior. Please complete the <u>Senior Intent Form</u> and submit it as soon as possible. Please be sure to complete the form accurately and correctly. Please know that part of this form will be utilized to ensure that each Seniors' name is printed correctly on their Diploma. We are asking Seniors to verify their full legal name (name that appears on their Birth Certificate). This information will be verified against the Birth Certificate in each Seniors' cumulative record. The name that appears on the student's Birth Certificate will be the name that will be printed on the Diploma. PROCESS FOR OBTAINING A DRIVER'S ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE: To meet the needs of our students and families, we will be implementing the following process to allow students to receive a Driver's Eligibility Certificate (DEC) while our school building is closed due to COVID-19. Please remember that DECs are only valid for 30 days; therefore, students are only eligible to receive a DEC during this time if they have a confirmed appointment with the NCDMV within 30 days of the date of the request. You will start by sending an email request to Ms. Teresa Brown (tbrown3@wcpss.net), Dean of Students, and include the email from NCDMV confirming the date/time of the appointment. You will receive an email confirming the date/time you can come to the high school to receive the DEC. Once your appointment is confirmed with us, the following steps will be taken:

- Step 1: Scan or take a photo of the following:
  - o Student's birth certificate or passport
  - o Completed Driver's Education Certificate (if it has not been emailed ahead of time)
  - o Proof of address if the current address is different than the one listed on the Driver's Education Certificate or the address listed in PowerSchool. Address must be verified for the NC Real ID.
  - Email this information to Ms. Brown, our designated contact at the school. This will limit the amount of paper that has to be exchanged by staff and students. If you are unable to scan or take a photo of the document, then you will need to bring all these documents with you to the appointment.
- Step 2: Bring the following documents to the appointment:
  - o Student's birth certificate or passport
  - o Completed Driver's Education Certificate (if it has not been emailed ahead of time)
  - o Proof of address if the current address is different than the one listed on the Driver's Education Certificate or the address listed in PowerSchool. Address must be verified for the NC Real ID.
- Step 3: Receiving the DEC:
  - Once you arrive for your appointment, a staff member will meet you at the front door of the school (entrance by the flagpole) to receive the DEC. It is important that we limit the amount of direct contact and maintain at least 6 feet of social distance. For this reason, please limit the number of family members (preferably just the student and a parent or guardian) who attend the appointment. Please arrive at the school promptly for your scheduled appointment to ensure that we can follow the social distancing guidelines that have been established.
  - Staff will check the student's grades for adequate progress. The student must have passed 70% of the courses taken in the prior semester to receive a DEC.
  - Once grades have been verified and all other documents are in place, the DEC can be issued to the student.

Thank you for your understanding and support of this new process to continue to provide DECs to our students.
