- 1. PLTs will review and analyze benchmark assessment data monthly in order to determine effectiveness of instruction.
- 2. PLTs will review and analyze walk-through data quarterly in order to determine fidelity of implementation and assess professional development needs.
- 3. PLTs will review the SIP review checklist quarterly for implementation and fidelity (agendas/minutes, student data trackers, PBL checklist, Quarterly Data Reviews and BOOST plan)

Action Step(s)

1. Horizontal and vertical PLTs will meet to align pacing, priority and secondary standards, instructional practices, and projects/assessments.

2. The principal and MTSS team will develop a building level schedule and human/material resources to reflect Math and ELA boost needs with an aligned building level approach.

- 3. PLTs and the PBIS team will review and analyze attendance data monthly in order to determine effectiveness of the tiered behavior intervention system.

Action Step(s)

1. Classroom teachers will implement a Class Meeting (daily 10 MIN or 30 min. weekly) focused on Building Relationships, Developing Growth Mindset, and Student Led Problem Solving.
