Brain Game Winners: Congratulations to the Enloe Brain Game Team who beat North Carolina School of Science and Mathematics at their competition on Saturday! Please watch them take the top spot on television when it airs on April 8. Way to go, scholars!

Progress Reports: We are midway through the third quarter of the school year. As such, scholars will receive their progress reports throughout this week. Please continue to contact your child's teachers with questions or concerns regarding grades. Continue to monitor the Parent PowerSchool portal to get an up-to-date account of your child's performance in all of their classes.

ACT Testing: On Tuesday, February 28, all juniors will take the ACT examination. This is a 4.5 hour test and all juniors are required to take it. All juniors will report to their testing locations at 7:20 am. They will need to bring a current photo ID, a calculator and #2 pencils. Testing locations are posted in the atrium, outside the media center and across from student services. All electronic devices must be powered down and placed in backpacks for the duration of the test. Their backpacks will be secured in the front of the classroom and will not be accessible until all testing has completed. This includes Smartwatches. Students are permitted to bring a snack and drink to consume during the break.

Orchestra Concert: Please support our student musicians, under the direction of Ms. McCollum as our orchestra department will have their seasonal concert on Tuesday, February 28 at 7 pm in the Enloe Auditorium!

IB Open House: On Thursday, March 2, we will host our annual International Baccalaureate Night starting at 6 pm in the Enloe Auditorium. Come out to learn more about the program, its structure and its benefits to your scholar. As we celebrate the twentieth year of the IB program, we are looking to expand opportunities for students.
