**October Scholarship Newsletter:** The October Scholarship Newsletter is posted on our school's website. To access this link, go to the Green Hope homepage and select **Student Services** under **Students**. Once you are on the Student Services homepage, you will select **Resources**, and the scholarship newsletter is located on that page. This newsletter is a great way to learn about various local and national scholarship opportunities.

**UNC Charlotte's Levine Scholars Program:** The Levine Scholars Program seeks exceptional high school seniors who demonstrate a commitment to community service, hold an academic record that reflects a sustained passion for knowledge and possess a capacity for ethical leadership that elevates fellow students to a higher standard. The program takes the brightest, most capable students and provides them with the tools, resources and environment they need to connect, transform and make a difference in the world. The total value of this four-year scholarship is estimated at **\$105,000** for in-state students and **\$155,000** for out-of-state students. To be considered for this scholarship opportunity, seniors must first be nominated by their school counselor. Interested students must complete a Scholarship Interest form and turn it in to their assigned counselor in Student Services by **October 11, 2016**. The interest form is located under "Forms" on the Student Services homepage.

**NCSU Goodnight Scholars Program:** The Goodnight Scholars Program is a program for middle-income students from North Carolina who are interested in majoring in a STEM or STEM-Education field. It was started in 2008 by Dr. Jim Goodnight of SAS Institute and accepts 50 rising college students every year. In addition to providing a full-ride to NC State, the Goodnight Scholars provides opportunities such as professional development, social programs, trips and enrichment funding for extracurricular opportunities.
