Timeline for Implementation:
Traditional and Modified Calendar Schools
Grades K-8

<p>First-Second Nine Weeks</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Parents notified of WCPSS Promotion and Intervention Policy 5530 ➤ PEPs developed for students not performing at grade level ➤ Parents may review PEPs for students not performing at grade level ➤ PEPs implemented for students not performing at grade level ➤ Parents receive interim and/or quarterly progress reports
<p>Third Nine Weeks</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ PEPs implemented for students not performing at grade level ➤ PEPs and student records reviewed for students at risk of retention ➤ Parents notified if student is at risk of retention by interim of third nine weeks ➤ Parents receive interim and/or quarterly student progress reports
<p>Fourth Nine Weeks <i>(During the Last Three Weeks of School)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ School-based review committee identifies, documents, and makes recommendations for K-8 students at risk of retention ➤ Promotion decision made for K-2 students ➤ K-2 parents notified of promotion decision and appeal process ➤ School administers first End-of-Grade tests for grades 3-8
<p>Fourth Nine Weeks <i>(Following End-of-Grade (EOG) Testing Through Last School Day)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Promotion decision made for 3-8 students who scored at Level III/IV on EOG tests ➤ Parents of students scoring below Level III on EOG test(s) notified of opportunities for retesting and interventions ➤ Teachers and/or parents may request a waiver from EOG promotion standards ➤ Short-term interventions implemented for students scoring below Level III on EOG test(s) ➤ Second EOG test(s) may be administered ➤ Promotion decision made for students scoring Level III/IV on second EOG test(s) ➤ Parents of students scoring below Level III on second EOG test(s) notified of opportunities for retesting and intervention ➤ Teachers and/or parents may request a waiver from EOG promotion standards ➤ Parents receive quarterly student progress reports
<p>Following End of School Year <i>(Before Beginning of Next School Year)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Third EOG test(s) may be administered ➤ Parents notified of results on third EOG test(s) and of promotion decision ➤ Teachers and/or parents may request a waiver from EOG promotion standards ➤ Parents of students scoring below Level III and recommended for promotion with intervention and parents or teachers requesting waivers from EOG promotion standards receive Review Committee schedule ➤ School-based and External Review Committees make promotion recommendations to principal ➤ Parents notified of promotion decision and appeal process
<p>Next School Year</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Interventions begin for Levels I and II students
