Table 1. 2003-04 Elementary Schools. 52,221 students are enrolled in 80 elementary schools. 29.1 percent of students are participating in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program (F&R), and 6.5 percent are enrolled in English as a Second Language Program (ESL) offered at 53 elementary schools. The overall campus capacity is for 49,452 students (including 355 mobile classrooms), with crowding percent of 105.6%.
