Table 3. 2003-04 High Schools. 30,433 students are enrolled in 16 high schools. 15.2 percent of students are participating in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program (F&R), and 2.9 percent are enrolled in English as a Second Language Program (ESL) offered at 10 high schools. The overall campus capacity is for 30,486 students (including 155 mobile classrooms), with crowding percent of 99.8%.
