**WAKE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM** **Table 4. 2003-04 Special/Optional Schools.** 369 students are enrolled in 3 special/optional schools. 41.5 percent of students are participating in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program (F&R), and no students are enrolled in English as a Second Language Program (ESL). The overall campus capacity is for 685 students (including 8 mobile classrooms), with crowding percent of 53.9%.
