**WAKE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM** **Table 4. 2004-05 Special/Optional Schools:** 339 students are enrolled in 3 special/optional schools. 53.98 percent of students are participating in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program (F&R), and no students are enrolled in English as a Second Language Program (ESL). The overall campus capacity is for 418 students (including 8 mobile classrooms), with crowding percent of 81.1%.
