Table 5. 2004-05 Schools: 114,068 students are enrolled in 132 schools. 26.3 percent of students are participating in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program (F&R), and 4.7 percent are enrolled in English as a Second Language Program (ESL) offered at 85 schools. The overall campus capacity is for 114,252 students (including 709 mobile classrooms), with crowding percent of 99.8%.
