Table 4. 2005-06 Special/Optional Schools. 314 students are enrolled in 4 special/optional schools. 60.74 percent of students are participating in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program (F&R), and no students are enrolled in English as a Second Language Program (ESL). The overall campus capacity is for 471 students (including 16 mobile classrooms), with crowding percent of 66.7%.
