Table 1. 2006-07 Elementary Schools. 62,363 students are enrolled in 93 elementary schools. 32.2 percent of students are participating in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program (F&R), and 6.8 percent are enrolled in English as a Second Language Program (ESL) offered at 68 elementary schools. The overall campus capacity is for 61,794 students (including 680 mobile classrooms), with crowding percent of 100.9%.
