Table 4. 2006-07 Special/Optional Schools. 345 students are enrolled in 4 special/optional schools. 64.1 percent of students are participating in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program (F&R), and no students are enrolled in English as a Second Language Program (ESL). The overall campus capacity is for 471 students (including 8 mobile classrooms), with crowding percent of 73.2%.
