Table 2. 2007-08 Middle Schools. 29,895 students are enrolled in 30 middle schools. 28.8 percent of students are participating in the Free and Reduced Lunch Program (F&R), and 3.0 percent are enrolled in English as a Second Language Program (ESL). The overall campus capacity is for 30,792 students (including 217 mobile classrooms), with crowding percent of 97.1%.
